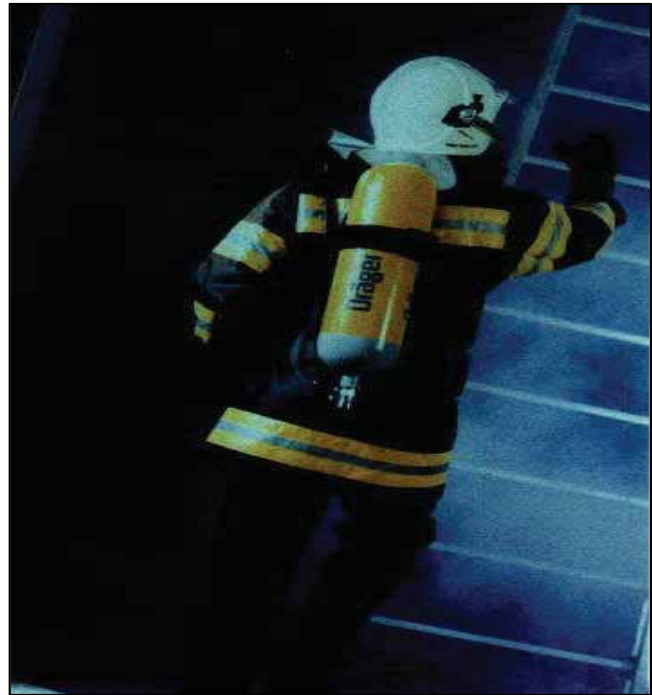
The Personal Safety System
